

**1<sup>st</sup> Annual Home Run Derby Day**

**Rules:** each player will get 7 outs (an out is any swing that does NOT result in a home run). The top 3 will advance to round 2 which will be 4 outs. The person with the most combined HRs in 2 rounds wins. As an example, if hitter 1 hits 5 HRs in round 1 and 2 HRs in round 2, that hitter has a total of 7 HRs and would beat a hitter that hit 3 HRs in round 1 and 3 HRs in round 2 for a total of 6 HRs. If there is a tie, 1<sup>st</sup> tiebreaker is the player with more HRs in round 2; 2<sup>nd</sup> tiebreaker would be age (younger player wins for kids and older player wins for adults). If there are fewer than 5 entrants in a category, it will only be 1 round.

**Categories/Divisions:**

AA Baseball – will hit from pitcher's mound on LL field  
AA Softball –will hit from pitcher's mound LL field  
AAA Baseball –will hit from home plate on LL field  
AAA Softball- will hit from determined spot of LL field  
Majors Baseball- will hit from home plate on LL field  
Majors Softball- will hit from determined spot on LL field  
All-Star -35 & Under Men- will hit from home plate on legion field  
All-Star -35 & Under Women- will hit from home plate on LL field  
Hall Of Fame–Over 35 Men- will hit from home plate on legion field  
Hall Of Fame-Over 35 Women- will hit from determined spot of LL field

**Prizes:**

Aside from bragging rights, trophies will be given to the winners & names will go on a Plaque to be displayed at the field. Names & photo will be posted in Forecaster and on website.

\*Pitching machines and screens to protect the pitchers/ball feeders will be set up on all 4 fields

## **Volunteers Needed**

For all fields, we will need the following:

- 1) Pitcher – someone to feed the balls into the machines
- 2) Official Scorer –someone to coordinate batters, swings & HRs
- 3) Safety Official & HR retriever – Someone to stand beyond the outfield fence to be sure people are watching and safe and do not get hit by balls being hit over the fence AND retrieve the balls and toss them back onto the field
- 4) Ball retrievers inside the fences (1 or 2 majors players or older to retrieve balls and refill pitching buckets
- 5) Snack Shack & Grill – it would be great to have the snack shack open for all to enjoy.
